- 1. Our relationship with God is most important.
 - a. Alpha and Omega (Beginning and the End) Genesis 1:1; Revelations 22:13
 - b. Elohim (The Creator) Genesis 2:7,18, 21-22
 - c. Yahweh, Omniscient (Lord, All-Knowing) Psalm 139:13-18
 - d. Hesed, Agape (Love) John 3:16; 1 John 4:16
 - e. Our relationship with God is the incubator of our relationship with others Luke 10:27
- 2. As we grow in God, our desire to find Him in the place of intimacy and the place of our needs (meeting place), should increase.
 - a. Jesus gave us direct access to God through the Holy Spirit. Ephesians 2:18
 - b. The meeting place teaches us who God is. Matthew 5:33
 - c. The meeting place teaches us who we are in Christ. 1 John 3:1
 - d. The meeting place teaches us how to conduct ourselves as disciples of Christ. Romans 12:9-21
 - e. Reconciliation and resolve first happen in the meeting place.
- 3. Reconciliation:
 - a. **Reconcile:** to make right; to make amends; to adjust the way you think about a fact or situation.
 - b. We have been reconciled to God. 2 Corinthians 5:17-18
 - c. We have been given the ministry of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:18-21
 - d. Reconciling our issues with God, always leads to a resolution with people.
- 4. Resolution:
 - a. **Resolve:** to deal with successfully; clear up; determine; come up with a definite or earnest decision about
 - b. What is your love fruit looking like? John 13:35
 - c. If it is at all possible. . . live at peace with everyone. Romans 12:18
